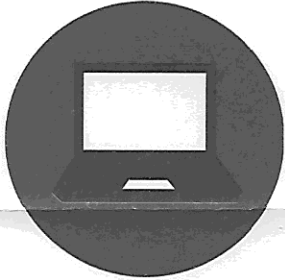


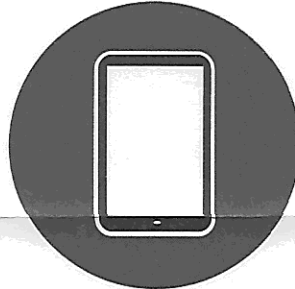
ELECTRONICS DISPOSAL BAN: JANUARY 1, 2018

The Sustainable Solid Waste Management Amendment Act (D.C. Official Code § 8-1041.01 et seq.) (20 DCMR § 4100-4199) states that as of January 1, 2018, "no person in the District shall knowingly dispose of covered electronic equipment or subassemblies of covered electronic equipment as solid waste in the District except through recycling programs or other methods approved by the Mayor."

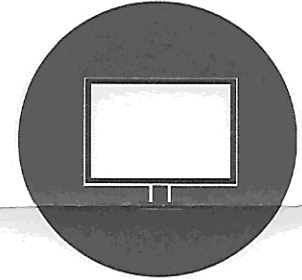
